

NEW STREET SIGNAL BOX (AREA C)

Designed by Bicknell and Hamilton the Birmingham New Street Signal Box is an example of brutalist architecture, it was built between 1964 and 1966 as part of the remodelling of New Street station and modernisation of the West Coast Mainline, which involved the electrification of the entire route.

The signal box was designated a grade II listed building in 1995 and was used until it was finally closed at the end of 2022.
