

NORTON TOWER (AREA 4)

There is not a lot of info on Norton Tower on the internet but I may do some primary research. As far as I could find out, Norton Tower was built by John Ambler in the late 1800s at 1000 ft above sea level and overlooked the Calderdale valley. The large house was a prominent landmark with its four-window tower.

The remaining garden balustrade is all that remains of Norton Tower and the view from the garden towards Halifax

John Ambler his father and brother William were in business at Luddenden until his father's death in 1901, when he wound up John Ambler and Sons, Ltd and began business as a worsted spinner at Wibsey near Bradford. From 1908 he was a director of brewers Samuel Webster and Sons (married into the Webster family).

The residence of Joseph Thomson, on his death became possession of Mr R V Thomas. Later the house and estate were separated in to building lots.
